- User Process

- starts at the time the user requests interaction to the Oracle server through an access tool
- establishes a connection through the server process

- Server Process

- starts when the user establishes a connection
- connects to the Oracle instance on behalf of the user process and opens a session

- Background Processes

- start when an Oracle instance is started
- maintain and enforce relationships between physical and memory structures
